There are so many different and fun ways to use these bingo sheets in your classroom or studio!
Here are just a few examples:

Ear Training:

- Play the different notes, chords or intervals for students to identify on their sheets
- To help, play a reference string or chord first

Give Descriptors:

- Describe each note by indicating lines and spaces on the staff instead of the actual note name
- Describe each note in relation to another note
- Name the notes used for the chord shape without saying the actual chord name

Assessment Ideas:

- Extra ear training: Have students number their answers on the sheet in the order that they hear you play them (pick 5-10 things that you want to focus on instead of the whole sheet)
- Quick check in: Point to a square and ask the student to play the note/chord, clap the rhythm, or give you a verbal definition
- Fill in the blanks: Ask students to write down all the names of the notes, chords, symbols and patterns
- Extension: identify all the notes in each chord shape
